The **International Rating "IAAR Eurasian University Ranking (IAAR EUR)"** methodology, developed by the Independent Agency for Accreditation and Rating (IAAR), aims to comprehensively assess the quality of higher educational institutions' activities, and builds on the international methodological standards for constructing rankings of **IREG (Observatory of Academic Ranking and Professional Development)**, empirical research standards and methods for integration of universities into the global educational and world research space.

The international rating "IAAR Eurasian University Ranking (IAAR EUR)" is constructed with reference to the digital technologies with Webometrics elements and excludes subjective approaches in assessment.
