- ❖ Accreditation of study programs: National (State) and (or) international accreditation.
- ❖ The ranking of HEI: National (State) and (or) International.
- ❖ Rating of study programs: National (State) and (or) International



THE QUALITATIVE COMPOSITION OF UNIVERSITY STUDENTS

- ❖ The student body of full-time faculty of the HEI.
- ❖ Double-degree study programs within the country.
- ❖ Graduate students that have a Hirsch-index according to Scopus data.
- ❖ Graduate students with patents and inventions.



CONCENTRATION OF THE HEI'S SCIENTIFIC POTENTIAL

- ❖ The scientific potential of the academic staff: academic degree holders rate, Dissertation Councils.
- ❖ Nobel Prize and Fields Medal winners.
- ❖ State prize winners of the Republics.
- ❖ Faculty that have a Hirsch-index according to Web of Science/ Scopus data.
- ❖ Faculty monographs published by Elsevier.
- ❖ Patents included in the Web of Science database.
