on the results of the work of the external expert committee for assessment for compliance with the standards of primary specialized accreditation of the academic program 6B01705 - Kazakh, Russian languages and literature, implemented by non-profit joint-stock company "Aktobe Regional University named after K.Zhubanov from November 23 to 25, 2022.

INTRODUCTION

In accordance with the Order №113-22 of 21.09.2022 of the Independent Agency of Accreditation and Rating from November 23 to 25, 2022 the external expert committee conducted compliance assessment of the academic program 6B01705 - Kazakh, Russian languages and literature at Aktobe Regional University named after K. Zhubanov with standards of specialized primary accreditation of higher and postgraduate academic organization program (№57-20-OD of June 16, 2020, edition six).

The report of the External Expert Committee (EEC) contains an assessment of the submitted academic program by the IAAR criteria, EEC recommendations for further improvement of the academic program and the parameters of the profile of the academic program.

EEC VISIT DESCRIPTION

The work of the EEC was carried out based on the approved Program of the Committee of Experts on the initial specialized accreditation of the academic program7M01701-Kazakh language and literature in the non-profit joint-stock company "Aktobe Regional University named after K. Zhubanov" from November 23 to 25, 2022.

In order to coordinate the work of the EEC on November 21, an on-line orientation meeting was held, during which the powers were distributed among the members of the commission, the schedule of the visit was clarified, an agreement was reached on the choice of methods of examination.

In order to obtain objective information about the quality of academic programs and the entire infrastructure of the university, to clarify the content of self-evaluation reports, meetings were held with the Rector, the Vice-Rector of the university on the areas of activity, heads of departments, heads of departments, teachers, students, graduates and employers. In total, all the planned representatives participated in the meetings (Table 1).

During the tour, members of the EEC familiarized themselves with the state of the facilities, visited the museum, library, classrooms, special classrooms, laboratories, computer labs, dormitory, departments, divisions, canteen and sports complex.

COMPLIANCE TO THE SPECIALIZED ACCREDITATION STANDARDS

6.1 "Academic Program Management"

The evidential part

The university has developed the Strategic Plan NPJSC "Aktobe Regional University named after K. Zhubanov" r for 2020-2024; standards of internal quality assurance of the university (http://zhubanov.edu.kz/ru/pages/bilim/normativtik-kukyktyk-baza/kosymshanormativtyk-kuzhattar.php.)

which regulate activities and policies in the field of education quality.

Based on the strategic documents, as well as taking into account the results of AP functioning and risk analysis, the AP development plans are developed, which contain an analysis of the current state (information on the contingent of students by levels, potential of teaching staff, state of material and technical base and research work, SWOT-analysis), main goals and objectives of AP development, planned indicators.

Academic program development plans are reviewed with the involvement of all stakeholders when discussing the reports on the activities of graduating departments, on the management of educational programmes, which is presented in the relevant documents of the departments.

The teaching staff of the accredited AP is involved in the management of the AP, which is seen through the updating of the AP taking into account the demand in the labour market and the latest developments in science; planning the volume of credits to study elective disciplines; defining the course policy; making a schedule of test assignments; organizing control of students' knowledge; defining forms and methods of teaching; managing practice, topics of graduate works; participation in the state attestation boards, collegiate bodies; filing requests to form the scientific and teaching fund.

Organization of research and development in the field of study at a satisfactory level: students annually participate in various debates and subject Olympiads, having the status of International, national, regional, as well as take part in scientific and practical conferences of different levels.

The University signed agreements on cooperation with Bashkir State Pedagogical University named after M. Akmulla, Xinjiang University (language program, CNR, Kazan Federal University; Universities of Kastamonu, Sakarya, Hacettepe (Republic of Turkey). Also, the Department maintains close academic ties with leading universities, research and other institutions of RK, such as Al-Farabi Kazakh National University, Daryn Centre at the Regional Office, Institute of Professional Development, City Research and Methodological Centre at CED.

The effectiveness and efficiency of the development of AP is confirmed by the fact that the students show good achievements in various competitions, Olympiads, have letters of commendation on the results of practices, positive feedback from employers.

The analytical part

EEC IAAR on the results of meetings, conversations and interviews with Vice-rectors, deans, heads of departments, heads and employees of structural units, students, faculty, representatives of employers and graduates, as well as conducting a survey of students and faculty, familiarizing in detail with the educational infrastructure of the University, logistical and information-methodological resources, as well as the necessary documents, noted Transparency of the process of forming the development plan of AP is confirmed by the participation of the rectorate, teaching and learning council, teaching staff, students, stakeholders, employers.

EEC confirms that the university has a published quality assurance policy, which reflects the link between research and learning and is oriented to the national and HEI context. The policy is systematically analysed by the management for compliance with the strategy, goals and objectives of the university, labour market requirements, and collective decisions are taken based on the results of the analysis. The policy focuses on student-centred learning, creation of the necessary educational environment, involvement of students in the quality assurance process. Interaction with employers, teaching students entrepreneurial and innovative skills is an important principle of quality assurance, so employers are involved in the development of AP, are involved in teaching and research processes.

EEC notes that the mechanisms of implementation of business processes, including AP management, are specified in detail in the normative documents of the university. The effectiveness and efficiency of AP development is confirmed by the fact that the students show

good achievements in various competitions, Olympiads, have letters of commendation on the results of internships, positive feedback from employers.

The experts note the active participation of university representatives, including heads of EPs, in the work of collegial bodies, which coordinate the management of APs.

The EEC confirms the openness and accessibility of university management and AP for students, teaching staff and other interested parties.

The proof of the high quality of AP is the orientation of HEI towards internationalization in general, reaching the international level, which is realized through the involvement of leading foreign specialists, introduction of innovative teaching methods, exchange of experience.

The survey of teaching staff conducted during the EEC visit of IAAR showed that the involvement of teaching staff in the process of making management and strategic decisions is very good and good - 95.1%; satisfied with the level of incentives for teaching staff and attracting young professionals to the educational process - 100%; not satisfied with the level of encouragement of innovative activities of teaching staff - 0.8%.

The strength/best practice of AP 6B01705 - Kazakh, Russian Languages and Literature:

- The individuality and uniqueness of the EP development plan, its consistency with national priorities and the development strategy of the higher and/or postgraduate education institution.

Recommendation of EEC for AP 6B01705 - Kazakh, Russian languages and literature:

- To the AP management to carry out an analysis of the risks of implementation of the EP declared for accreditation, to assess the possibilities to manage them, as well as to develop and implement ways to prevent adverse factors. The deadline is 31.03.2023.

The EEC conclusions on the Standard "Academic Program Management": AP 6B01705 - Kazakh, Russian languages and literature has one strong, 13 - satisfactory positions, one - suggesting improvement position.

6.2. Standard "Reporting and Information Management" The evidential part

The university has a system for collecting and analysing internal and external data in order to make the necessary decisions. For this purpose, modern information technologies and software tools, electronic document management systems and IPC "Univer" are used. The main information distribution tool is the university website http://zhubanov.edu.kz/ru/. On a server of system "Univer" working through protected report Https with the enciphering, it is established Symantec Endpoint Protection - a complex antivirus and a firewall with several levels of safety. Currently, the Univer system has a complete database of students in all levels of training and forms of education, teaching staff and other employees, grouped into user groups with individual rights, with differentiation of access to information resources.

In October 2019, the mobile application "Smart ARSU" was launched for students, parents and teachers of K. Zhubanov University.

The University has a scientific library http://library.arsu.kz/?page_id=122; corporate e-mail: zhubanov@mail.ru.

The following mechanisms for collecting, storing and analyzing information on AP implementation are in place at HEI: system of monitoring the implementation of plans for AP development; internal self-evaluation in preparation for audits of various university

departments; self-evaluation in preparation for institutional and specialized accreditation; annual monitoring of processes for AP implementation.

In general, the EEC notes that the university uses modern information systems, information and communication technologies and software in information management.

The evidential part

Users of the mobile application "Smart ARSU", launched in October 2019, in the section "ARSU Life" will be able to view the schedule of classes, sections, clubs and events in a convenient format, follow the university news and receive information about the teachers, buildings and dormitories, educational units of the university.

The EEC notes that the minutes of the department meetings reflect the results and analysis of the implementation of the objectives of AP, ways of improvement and effectiveness of AP.

The University conducts sociological research among students, graduates, teaching staff in order to identify their opinions on the quality of professional activities of teachers, on the level of session organization, on academic performance, on the quality of managerial activities, involvement in research and other important issues of the educational process.

The implemented KPI systems, the rating assessment of teaching staff, departments and institutes, the survey of teaching staff and students reflect the effectiveness and efficiency of the activities of structural units. The University's performance is also confirmed by its participation in various national and international rankings.

The survey of students conducted during the visit of EEC IAAR showed that the satisfaction with the content and information content of the website of educational organisations in general and faculties in particular is 94.8%;

Informing students about the requirements for successfully graduating with a given major - 95.9%; informing students about courses, educational programmes and the academic degree obtained - 94.8%.

The EEC conclusions on the Standard "Information Management and Reporting": AP 6B01705 - Kazakh, Russian Languages and Literature has 0 strong, 16 satisfactory, 0 - suggesting improvement position.

6.3 Standard "Development and approval of an academic program" The evidential part

The accredited Program is developed and approved on the basis of normative documents of MES RK and internal documents of the University. The educational programme is developed by the university independently in accordance with the SES (Order of the MES RK No. 604 of October 31, 2018. New edition of #182, dated 5.05.2020, Order of MES RK #2 dated 20.07.2022); Standard Rules of the educational organization implementing educational programs of higher and postgraduate education (Order of MES RK dated October 30, 2018 #595. New edition № 182, dated 5.05.2020); Charter of K. Zhubanov ARU, "Regulations on the construction of a modular educational program" dated 12.08.2020, which reflects the main stages of the development and approval of AP, as well as the process of their updating.

The expected learning outcomes of the Program are presented in the graduate model.

The development of AP 6B01705 - Kazakh, Russian languages and literature is carried out stage by stage with the direct participation of teaching staff, students, employers, heads of practicums. The working group consisting of teachers and employers discusses and forms the curriculum, determines the importance and necessity of certain competences of the PG. The developed Program of Study Programs undergoes internal and external expertise. The leading teachers of the department and members of the academic committees of the Faculty, University, conduct internal expertise; the employers conduct external expertise.

The grounds for unplanned revision of AP can be: changes of SES, TEO, EP; changes of labor market requirements.

The CED is updated at the end of the academic year by introducing new courses at the request of students.

The analytical part

The accredited AP is developed in accordance with the defined level of preparation of the National Qualifications Framework, the Professional Standard of Education, level 1,2,3 of the Dublin Descriptors, ESG standards. The undergraduate program corresponds to Level 6 of the Sectoral Qualifications Framework (SQF).

The CED includes disciplines as requested by employers.

Experts note the consistency of the process of AP formation, including from data collection and analysis to final approval.

The involvement of employers is stipulated in the "Regulation on Building Modular Education System".

The content of AP includes different types of activities: theoretical course, professional practice, research work, which contribute to the formation and development of professional competencies taking into account their personal, socio-cultural characteristics and planned outcomes. Determination of compliance of the content of academic disciplines and learning outcomes with the level of education (Bachelor's, Master's, Doctoral studies) takes place through external and internal expertise. The expert-teachers of the department conduct internal expertise, head of department, as well as by the learners during the questionnaire on the quality of the studied course. External examination of compliance of the content of academic disciplines and learning outcomes with the level of education is carried out with the involvement of employers, as well as the study of the experience of Al-Farabi Kazakh National University, West Kazakhstan University named after M. Otemisuly.

However, the EEC notes that an important principle in the design of the AP is harmonization with the academic program of domestic and foreign partners for the implementation of academic mobility program. Currently, the AP management does not undertake any actions to explore the possibility of hormonalisation of the AP.

In general, the development of APs in the cluster is a reasonable, purposeful process, oriented towards the achievement of the results by the learners in accordance with the normative documents. The effectiveness of this process is confirmed by the results of the survey of the learners who indicated full satisfaction with the quality of curricula in SPs - 94,%; as well as 69,5% of the learners expressed full agreement and 21,7% agreed that the course content is well structured.

Strengths/best practices of AP 6B01705 - Kazakh, Russian languages and literature:

- The existing potential to prepare bilingual graduates able to work in both Kazakh- and Russian-language educational institutions.

Recommendation to EEC for AP 6B01705 - Kazakh, Russian languages and literature:

- Consider the possibility of developing a joint AP with domestic higher education institutions by January 2024.

Conclusions of the EEC on the Standard "Development and approval of the academic program": AP 6B01705 - Kazakh, Russian languages and literature has 0 strong, 12 satisfactory, 0 - suggesting improvement position.

6.4 Standard "Continuous monitoring and periodic evaluation of academic program"

The evidential part

On the basis of normative documents ongoing monitoring, periodic assessment and updating of AP is carried out to ensure effective implementation of AP and the creation of a

favorable learning environment at the level of departments, faculties, the rectorate for compliance with the objectives, completeness of the requirements of educational standards, as well as to assess the quality of education.

At the university level, the Strategic Planning Centre carries out monitoring.

Analysis of the state of the educational process is carried out weekly at the meeting of the rectorate with the participation of vice-rectors, the Educational and Methodological Centre, departments with the adoption of specific decisions. The quality of educational services is systematically reviewed at the meetings of the rectorate and the Academic Council of the University.

The EEC notes that the main role in improving the curriculum is assigned to the teaching staff, as it is the teacher who interacts both with the content of the program and with the students. It is the teaching staff who are engaged in providing the requested information, completing the necessary documentation, i.e. constant purposeful professional activity.

The EEC notes that, in general, the K.Zhubanov ARU, and the management of the AP 6B01705 - Kazakh, Russian languages and literature, in particular, monitor and periodically evaluate the AP in order to ensure the achievement of quality education and meet the needs of students and society.

The analytical part

In order to analyse external changes, the Program is monitored between graduates and potential employers in the labour market in the form of interviews, questionnaires, roundtable discussions.

In order to achieve the objectives of AP, various methods of monitoring are used, including questionnaires, open classes, self-attendance, examinations by independent professors, control by the relevant units, expertise of SP by external stakeholders. The achievement of the AP objectives is also facilitated by inviting famous foreign scholars for guest lectures, organising and conducting courses, professional development seminars for the teaching staff and AP management.

The EEC notes that in developing APs the developers take into account the needs of the state, society and the region.

The quality of AP is determined by its relevance. The survey showed that 98.4% of the teaching staff agreed with the statement "the content and quality of the academic program corresponds to the expectations of the labour market and employers"; "informing students about the courses, academic program and academic degree" was fully agreed by 75.2%, agreed by 19.6% of the students.

Strengths/Best Practice AP 6B01705 - Kazakh, Russian Languages and Literature: - no strengths identified.

Recommendation of EEC for AP 6B01705 - Kazakh, Russian languages and literature:

- Not available.

Conclusions of the EEC: according to the Standard "Continuous Monitoring and Periodical Evaluation of Academic Programs" AP 6B01705 - Kazakh, Russian languages and literature has 10 criteria, of which 10 have a satisfactory position.

6.5 Student-centered learning, teaching and assessment standard *The evidential part*

The academic policy of the university is aimed at meeting the needs of different categories of students. The university has the following groups of learners: working youth; student-

athletes; students taking active part in the activities of public organizations; learners with special educational needs; international students.

The University provides all students with equal opportunities regardless of the language of instruction to form an individual academic program aimed at the formation of professional competencies

The Centre for Change Management and Quality Assessment of Education together with the graduating departments conducts a survey "Student Satisfaction with the results of training". In addition, students' feedback is carried out through their personal appeals to the university administration, faculty, department, through curators and student self-government.

Independence and autonomy of students of AP 6B01705-Kazakh, Russian language and literature is carried out by providing them with comprehensive support and assistance, for example, through the methodological settings and recommendations at lectures, conducting collective and individual consultations, discussions, classes on students' independent work, etc.

The assessment tools, mechanism and criteria are transparent. Students receive information on assessment criteria and methods from the syllabus and guidebook.

A student who disagrees with the result of the interim assessment shall submit an appeal no later than the next working day after the examination.

Univer system reflects the results of the current control (weekly), as well as the results of the midterm and final control after the current exams.

The EEC notes that in general the HEI, and the management in particular, are consistent, transparent and objective mechanisms for assessing the learning outcomes of the AP. Criteria and methods of assessment of learning outcomes are published in advance.

The analytical part

In the syllabuses provided by the EEC of the accredited AP the grading policy consisting of the letter-point system is given.

Assessment of knowledge is regulated in the documents of the university "Regulations on the current control of progress and interim attestation (examination session) of students", "Regulations on the final attestation of students", "Regulations on the organization and conduct of summer semester", "Instructions on the organization and conduct of the final control of knowledge (examinations) of students in written form", "Instructions on the organization and conduct of the boundary control and interim attestation in the form of form and computer testing.

The EEC states that the ARU adheres to the principles of student-centered learning in all the disciplines of the curriculum.

The EEC believes that the leadership of the AP has demonstrated mechanisms for student autonomy, while being guided and assisted by the teacher.

The EEC notes that the feedback with students is carried out through their personal appeals to the leadership of the university, faculty, department, through tutors and student self-government.

The tools, mechanism and criteria of assessment are reflected in the syllabuses of each teacher, the regulations of the educational process and the guidebook

The HEI has demonstrated the existence of a mechanism for objective, accurate and comprehensive assessment of knowledge through the built-up system of assessment of current control, interim and final attestation, the use of entrance knowledge cut-offs. Assessment methods include the whole range of written and oral tests, colloquiums, tests/exams

At the same time, the EEC notes the insufficiency of its own research in the field of teaching methodology of AP disciplines.

The conducted survey showed that 94.1% of students are satisfied with the quality of the educational program in general, 95.5% with the quality of teaching in general, 94.9% with the existing teaching resources of the HEI.

Recommendation of the EEC for the AP 6B01705 - Kazakh, Russian languages and literature:

- To prepare a plan for the development and implementation in the educational process of their own research faculty in the field of teaching methodology of academic disciplines with subsequent implementation. Deadline: September 2023.

Conclusions of the EEC: according to the Standard "Student-centered learning, teaching and assessment of learning outcomes" AP 6B01705 - Kazakh, Russian languages and literature has 0 strong, 9 satisfactory, 1 - suggestive of improvement.

6.6 The "Students" Standard *The evidential part*

The University established partnerships with 50 higher educational institutions of Kazakhstan and concluded 175 agreements with foreign universities on international cooperation in education and science.

K. Zhubanov ARU within the framework of internal academic mobility concluded an agreement with the following partner universities: L.N. Gumilev Eurasian National University, Kazakh National University named after Al-Farabi, Kyzylorda University named after Korkyt Ata, Kazakh National Pedagogical University named after Abay, Kazakh National Pedagogical University, Kazakh National Pedagogical University of the Republic of Kazakhstan. Abai Kazakh National Pedagogical University, M. Utemisov West Kazakhstan University.

Coordination of academic mobility program in the university is carried out by the K. Zhubanov ARU Centre for International Cooperation (external academic mobility) and the Centre for evaluation of educational program (internal academic mobility), with which the responsible departmental officers are in close contact.

Since 20 May 2020, a new online platform-digital job fair for its graduates and employers-is opened at K. Zhubanov ARU https://facultetus.kz/fairs/arsu/manage.

The management of AP 6B01705-Kazakh, Russian languages and literature is systematically working on the conclusion of contracts with enterprises of the city and region in order to expand the base of practice.

For effective work on employment, to assist students and graduates in choosing the field of professional development at K.Zhubanov ARU there is a department of vocational guidance and admission. The department holds open meetings with employers, job fairs and assists in job placement. There is no information on employment on accredited AP, as the graduation is expected in 2023.

The University has developed "The concept of educational work of Aktobe Regional University named after K.Zhubanov" and internal normative documents, such as "Regulations on Student Parliament", "Regulations on the curator of the student academic group", "Regulations on the Board of curators", "Regulations on student houses", which are basic normative documents on educational work.

To organize educational work at the HEI, the Department of Social Affairs and Youth Policy has been established, which includes the Youth Affairs Committee. In addition, the university has a student parliament, a student dormitory council, a sports club, a delinquency prevention council, etc.

For the harmonious development of personality, the development of moral, civil, patriotic and general cultural competences of students in the K. Zhubanov ARU. There are various hobby clubs, such as the debating club "Ritor", the "Zaman Bizdiki" Union of Intellectual Elites (debating club), the School of Legal Knowledge, the student theatre "Zhubanov Zhastary", Young writers and poets club, English club FM, Education club, charitable club Ymitin yzilmesin, Zubanov zhyluy and Ecolife volunteer club, Sanaly Yrpaq student club, Public service school "Mansap", KVN club, ARSU media centre, office of psychological and pedagogical consultation "Sana", park of innovative technologies, TV and radio studio,

museum, Coworking zone, scientific and creative association "Gibrat", choir, dombrists orchestra, model agency "University", dancing groups "Big fam" and "ARSU STARS", student film club "Zhubanov Cinema" and etc. The projects "Zhubanov kerueni" and "Aktobe ktangerli" are being implemented, as well as training centers, such as the student media centre "Bastau.kz", and foreign language training is available in Chinese, Polish, Korean and Turkish.

In order to support gifted students, the university has established a system of flexible payment terms and an extensive system of incentives. The university has a Regulation on grants and benefits provided to students and master students (http://zhubanov.edu.kz/ru/pages/bilim/normativtik-kukyktyk-baza/kosymsha-normativtyk-kuzhattar.php).

The analytical part

Adhering to the principles of openness and accessibility to the public, Aktobe Regional University named after K. Zhubanov in the open access places complete, objective information about the activities of the university, the rules of admission of applicants, educational programs, terms and forms of training, international programs and partner universities, the advantages of the university and each department, information about graduate employment, contact and other useful for applicants and students information on various information media. The official website of K. Zhubanov ARU, which provides information in the faculties section, is the main channel of public information (applicants, parents, students, graduates and employers). The university newspaper Zhubanov University is published monthly and the magazine University Khabarshysy is published once a quarter. The "Open Doors Day" at K. Zhubanov ARU is held 1-2 times a year. Teachers participate in events aimed at informing students, applicants and all interested parties.

The EEC notes that the university has demonstrated a mechanism for supporting gifted students.

At the same time, the EEC believes that the HEI has failed to fully demonstrate the existence of a functioning alumni association.

The conducted questionnaire indicated that the relationship with the deanery is fully satisfied 73.5%; existing educational resources of the institution - 94.9%; responsiveness to feedback from teachers on the educational process - 96.5%; Quality of services in libraries and reading rooms - 93.7%; Informing students about courses, educational programs and obtaining academic degrees - 94.8%; students.

6.7 Standard "Teaching staff"

The evidential part

At K.Zhubanov ARU the Regulation on personnel policy (02.09.2019), according to which the main purpose of the personnel policy is to ensure the processes of updating and maintaining the number and quality of staff in accordance with the needs of the university, the requirements of the current legislation of RK and the state of the labour market. Competitive selection of candidates to fill vacant positions is carried out in accordance with the qualification characteristics of scientific and pedagogical staff, the announcement of the competition is placed in national and regional newspapers: "Egemen Kazakhstan", "Kazakhstanskaya Pravda", "Aktobe" and "Aktobe Herald", "Zhubanov University", the university website.

An important factor is the development of academic mobility within the AP, attracting the best foreign and domestic teachers. In December 2021 PhD, associate professor of Gumushane University Zhyhanger Kyzylösen (Turkey) held classes for students of Kazakh department of Philology Department, including OP Kazakh, Russian languages and literature according to the plan. In the first half of 2021-2022 academic year in the framework of attraction of foreign scholars A.A. Evtyugina (Russian State Pedagogical University, Ekaterinburg, Russia) gave lectures for undergraduates and students of Russian Department of Philological Faculty, which were attended by students of accredited educational program.

All teachers of the department prepared lectures-presentations on basic and major disciplines. Besides, teachers supplement the presented new material with presentations made by means of CamStudio and Bandicam programs.

The following teachers have developed MOOCs: K.K. Sadirova, A.A. Imangazina, M.T. Kushtaeva, N.A. Sadoakas, Y.J. Ulukpanova.

The analytical part

The EEC believes that the information about the faculty members posted in open access on the website in three languages is limited to factual data and their scientific interests should be more fully reflected.

Over the past 5 years, 10 teachers (JSC NIS, Nursultan, RK), 2 teachers in pedagogical skills have passed training courses on inclusive education within the framework of advanced training - under the program of updated content of primary education (Online course. Al-Farabi Kazakh National University.), 4 teachers completed advanced training courses abroad (Prague, Charles University Faculty of Education, Czech Republic; Tashkent, Uzbekistan; Ankara, Turkey, Sterlitamak, RF), 6 teachers of the departments took courses organized by JSC "NTsPK "Orleu" IPK PR on the topics:

The following topics are included in this book: "The Digital Literacy and Pedagogical Technology" and "Digital Pedagogy for Teachers".

The EEC notes that the university has demonstrated the compliance of the staff potential of the teaching staff with the development strategy of the university and the specifics of the AP, as well as its scientific and creative potential, while the site does not fully provide information about personalities, achievements of the teaching staff.

EEC conclusions: according to the Standard "Teaching staff" AP 6B01705 - Kazakh, Russian languages and literature has 0 strong, 9 satisfactory, 0 - suggesting improvement position.

6.8 Standard "Educational Resources and Student Support Systems" The evidential part

The EEC generally notes that the ARU named after K. Zhubanov has sufficient material and technical base to ensure the educational process and implement the mission, goals and objectives of the university. The university is taking measures aimed at improving resource provision. The learning environment includes material and technical equipment that corresponds to the plans for the implementation of educational programs.

The material and technical base of the university includes 6 educational buildings, the Palace of Students for 800 seats, Zhastar sheds, the House of Students, a sports hall, a sports complex, sports facilities, and a clinic. Also, "Zhastar Uyi" for 500 seats, a three-story laboratory building (technopark) and a woodworking training and production workshop were opened. The total area of buildings and structures is 113,970.3 m2. The library is located in all educational buildings, in the House of Students and at the Confucius Institute. To provide students with a wider range of library and information services, there are library halls in all educational buildings and dormitories.

The classroom fund as a whole corresponds to the goals of the educational program. The EP has 3 multimedia language laboratories, an intercultural communication room, a video room, a sound room, 4 computer classes, about 30 classrooms of various sizes.

For carrying out high-quality educational activities, the level of information support (library, educational, methodological and informational) is important. The Fund of the Scientific Library of the ARU named after K. Zhubanov has a website https://library.arsu.kz/, where the Bulletin of New Acquisitions and a virtual exhibition are located. The library is focused on providing the educational process and research work in all areas of the university.

The volume of the fund is formed in strict accordance with the profile of the university specialties. In percentage terms, the book fund is represented by: educational, educational and methodical - 70.6%, fiction - 5.9%, scientific literature - 23.5%, the fund of industry, sociopolitical and popular scientific periodicals is also replenished annually upon request departments and subdivisions of libraries, through an annual subscription to newspapers and magazines of the Republic of Kazakhstan, the Russian Federation.

According to the state program "Rukhani Zhangyru" and thanks to the financing of the university, the scientific works of the teaching staff of the university are published in the serial format "Zhubanov kitapkhanasy".

Replenishment of the fund for 2 years: in 2021 - 21,000 copies. books 1812 titles (textbooks and teaching aids - 18,606 copies), including in the state language - 11,700 copies. In 2022, 538 copies have been purchased to date.

The library uses both traditional (alphabetic and systematic) and electronic catalog "IRBIS-64".

The analytical part

EEC notes that the need for the purchase of equipment and software is determined by the departments (Minutes of the meeting of the Kazakh Philology Department № 8 dated 29.04.2022, the Department of Russian and MSU (№ 8 dated 27.04.2022). The need is determined in accordance with the list of equipment and software products specified in the standard program. When purchasing equipment and software products, those models and series that are similar, used in the work in the relevant industry, are specified. The university's website provides access to the most up-to-date information. On the university website, each department has a separate page, built on the principles of orientation to applicants, students and other interested parties. The Faculty page with links to social pages is used to inform applicants, students, and all interested parties and is systematically updated.

During the EEC visit, it was found that there was poor functioning of Wi-Fi on campus, there were difficulties in the process of organizing online meetings with focus groups, despite the fact that the university is trying to update and acquire software.

6.9 The Public Information Standard *The evidential part*

The heads of the departments of Kazakh Philology, Russian Philology and Intercultural Communication use different ways to disseminate information: the official website of the university (http://zhubanov.edu.kz/), media, information networks, web resources (official pages on Instagram, Facebook, Vkontakte, YouTube-channel Zhubanov University), as well as the monthly newspaper "Zhubanov University".

Teaching staff of Kazakh Philology and Russian Philology and Intercultural Communication Departments hold various seminars, "Open Doors" days, meetings with faculty

graduates, extensive advertising and branding work in the media and social networks (https://www.instagram.com/p/CbpIz0mM7Mc/?igshid=MDJmNzVkMjY=,

https://www.facebook.com/russkaya.filologiya,

https://youtube.com/channel/UCxKkv5o1PfLEQxd43IYWI1w), where all information about the activities is posted.

There was a competition of traditional research projects organized on the basis of "Zhubanov kerueni". The contest of research projects for school graduates consisted of two stages. Several candidates participated, and 4 students made it to the next stage (after checking their uniqueness in the Turnitin system) and defended their research projects. Cultural and mass work of the departments is aimed at fostering in young people the spirit of patriotism, strengthening and popularizing national and family values. The analytical part

Employees and students of the Faculty of Philology regularly inform the general public about the activities of the K. Zhubanov ARU through publications on the website of the university, meetings with teachers and students of the city. Teachers are actively working with educational organizations of Aktobe and Aktobe region, a number of activities covered in the media.

Cultural and mass work of the departments is aimed at fostering in young people the spirit of patriotism, strengthening and popularizing national and family values. Essay contest "My contribution to a brighter future" was held under the "Organization of young writers" in the faculty. Students and high school students participated in the contest. docs.google.com/forms/d/1vi5bxnbUGiZrNOE_SW.

The EEC notes that, in general, the K. Zhubanov ARU and the management of AP 6B01705 - Kazakh, Russian languages and literature, in particular, use different ways of disseminating information. In this direction, information systems and technologies are used in two aspects: information systems and technologies in the educational process (quality control and assessment of training, indicators, criteria and evaluation methods, etc.) and informatization of department management (subsystems of university management automation).

Currently, there are three social media pages for each department, where all the information about the activities is posted. Many contests, flash mobs, events are also reflected on social media pages.

At the same time, the EEC believes that the website of the K. Zhubanov ARU does not fully reflect the information about the teaching staff, in the context of personalities.
