## **(II) INTRODUCTION**

In accordance with Order No. 16-22-OD dated 19.01.2022 of the Independent Accreditation and Rating Agency, from March 28 to March 30, 2022, an external expert commission conducted an online assessment of the compliance of educational programs of the NAO "Korkytat Kyzylorda University" with the standards of specialized primary accreditation of the NAAR (Ex-ante) (put into effect by the order of the director of the NU "NAAR" No.68-18/1-OD dated May 25, 2018):

7M01407 – Music education,

7M01722 – Russian language and literature,

6B01784 – Russian language and literature in schools with a non-Russian language of instruction.

The report of the external expert commission contains an assessment of the presented educational programs of the NAO "Korkytat Kyzylorda University" according to the criteria of the NAAR and the recommendations of the EEC for their further improvement.

### **(III) REPRESENTATION OF THE EDUCATIONAL ORGANIZATION**

The Kyzylorda Pedagogical Institute was opened in 1937 on the basis of the Far Eastern Korean Pedagogical Institute.

The non-profit joint stock Company "Korkyt Ata Kyzylorda University" was established on the basis of the Korkytat Kyzylorda Humanitarian University and the I.Zhakhayev Kyzylorda Polytechnic Institute (Resolution of the Government of the Republic of Kazakhstan No. 256 of March 24, 1998).

The Republican state enterprise on the right of economic management "Korkyt Ata Kyzylorda State University" was reorganized into a non-profit Joint Stock Company "Korkyt Ata Kyzylorda University" on the basis of the Decree of the Government of the Republic of Kazakhstan dated October 11, 2019 No. 752 "On certain issues of higher education institution of the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan"; Order of the Chairman of the State Property and Privatization Committee of the Ministry of Finance of the Republic of Kazakhstan No. 315 dated May 25, 2020 "On the establishment of a non-profit joint stock company "Korkyt Ata Kyzylorda University" dated July 01, 2020.

As part of five institutes, there are 26 departments that train specialists: Bachelor's degree - 64 Educational programs, Master's degree - 35 OP, PhD Doctorate - 13 EP.

Currently, the contingent of students of the university is 7910 people: Bachelor's degree – 7175, Master's degree – 701, PhD doctorate - 34 students.

The educational process is carried out by 482 full-time teachers, including: 23 doctors of sciences, 34 PhD doctors, 173 candidates of sciences, 190 masters.

The university has 10 academic buildings, 5 dormitories, a Palace of students, 7 student canteens, a sports and recreation complex "Seyhun", a military training ground, a library with 6 reading rooms.

KU Korkyt ata has passed institutional accreditation and 102 educational programs – specialized accreditation.

According to the results of the National Ranking of demand for universities in 2021, conducted by the Independent Accreditation and Rating Agency (NAAR), the University is in the TOP 20 of the General Ranking of Universities of the Republic of Kazakhstan, taking 7th place.

According to the National Rating of the Republic of Kazakhstan – 2021, conducted by the Independent Agency for Quality Assurance in Education (NAOKO), the university ranks 8th among multidisciplinary universities of the Republic of Kazakhstan.

KU Korkyt Ata is a member of:

Since 1992, the university has published a multi-circulation newspaper of the university "Syr Tulegi", and since 1999 the scientific journal "Bulletin of the Korkytat University".

EP 7M01722 – Russian language and literature, 7M01407 – Music education were developed and entered into the Register of the OP of the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan in 2020. The educational activities of the cluster are carried out on the basis of a license (no. KZ 67LAA00018492) issued by the Committee for Quality Assurance in the Field of Education and Science of the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan on 28.07.2020.

In the 2020-2021 academic year, a new EP 6B01784 – Russian language and literature in schools with a non-Russian language of instruction was developed, approved and recommended for inclusion in the Register of the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan. Admission of students to this OP is planned for the 2022-2023 academic year.

The contingent of students according to the presented cluster options is:

EP 7M01722 - Russian language and literature. – 12 people: (2020-21 academic year – 3 people, 2021-22 academic year – 9 people). The language of instruction is Russian

EP 7M01407 – Music education - 4 people (2020-21 academic year – 3 people, 2021-22 academic year – 1 hour). The language of instruction is Kazakh

The research activity of the teaching staff of the Department of Russian Language and Literature is conducted in two directions: 1) Actual problems of modern linguistics and literary studies, 2) Modern methods and techniques of teaching philological disciplines.

The personnel of the cluster's educational programs is staffed in accordance with the legislation of the Republic of Kazakhstan and the Rules of competitive replacement of positions of the teaching staff and researchers of the Korkyt Ata University (Protocol No. 2 of 03.03.20121). The teaching staff of the departments corresponds to the areas of bachelor's and master's degree training (Order No. 522-a of 31.12.2020; <https://korkyt.edu.kz/images/doljnosteisotrudnikov.pdf>).

**(III) DESCRIPTION OF THE PREVIOUS ACCREDITATION PROCEDURE**

Russian Russian Language and Literature Educational programs 7M01407 – Music education, 7M01722 – Russian language and Literature and 6B01784 – Russian language and literature in schools with a non-Russian language of instruction undergo the procedure of primary specialized accreditation.

**(IV) DESCRIPTION OF THE EEC VISIT**



The work of the EEC was carried out on the basis of the Program of the visit of the independent external expert commission on specialized accreditation of educational programs at the Korkyt Ata Kyzylorda University in the period from March 28 to March 30, 2022.

To obtain objective information about the quality of educational programs and the entire infrastructure of the university, to clarify the content of self-assessment reports, meetings were held with the rector, vice-rectors, directors of institutes, heads of structural divisions of the university, heads of departments, teachers, students, graduates, employers. A total of 68 people took part in the meetings (*Table 5*).

As part of the EEC visit, online classes were organized:

**- by EP 7M01407 – Music Education:**

1. Discipline "Management in music education". Topic: "The essence of the management of educational institutions". Teacher: PhD, senior lecturer Baigulova G.B. Id: 813 0821848. Access code: tD3Ujy. During the lesson, the teacher demonstrated the use of various teaching methods using an interactive whiteboard, PowerPoint presentations, tasks for self-control and independent work were given. Undergraduates took an active part in the lesson, answered the questions posed.

2. The discipline "Fundamentals of the updated content of education". Topic: "Goals and objectives, features and principles of music reproduction in the 4th grade in the updated content of education" Teacher: PhD, senior lecturer Bayulov G.B. Id: 813 0821848. Access code: tD3Ujy. During the lesson, the teacher demonstrated the use of various teaching methods using an interactive whiteboard, musical material was used, tasks were given to repeat and consolidate the material. Undergraduates showed musical and theoretical knowledge, activity in discussing a new topic.

**- by EP 7M01722 – Russian language and literature**

3. Discipline "Language and communication" (lecture), lecturer, PhD, Professor Sabitova Z. K. RYAL-21-2m Id: 87200053762, Access code – 004625. The lecture was held in an interactive mode; the knowledge of the students of the OP regarding the types of communication was updated. In addition, the teacher used elements of the "inverted classroom" technology; the lesson was conducted using an interactive whiteboard and a Power Point presentation.

4. Discipline "Stylistics of the modern Russian language" (practical lesson). Teacher: Makhanova A.A. The lesson was conducted using an interactive whiteboard and a PowerPoint presentation, the form of the discussion.

The topics of the classes correspond to the syllabus. The classes were conducted at the proper methodological level using methods of fixing the material with explanations, a consistent transition to the independent performance of tasks.

During the work, EEC members got acquainted with the EP cluster practice bases

The procedures planned during the EES IAAR visit contributed to a detailed familiarization of experts with the university's infrastructure, material and technical resources, teaching staff, employers, students and graduates, which allowed the VEC to conduct an independent assessment of the compliance of educational programs of the NAO "Korkytat Kyzylorda University" with the criteria of the standards of specialized primary accreditation of IAAR (Ex-ante.)

#### **(IV) COMPLIANCE WITH SPECIALIZED ACCREDITATION STANDARDS**

- ✓ *The management of the EP must demonstrate evidence of readiness for openness and accessibility for students, teaching staff, employers and other interested parties.*

##### ***Evidence***

Educational activities of the Korkyt Ata University under the programs: 7M01407 - Music Education, 7M01722 - Russian Language and Literature, 6B017 84 - Russian Language and Literature in schools with non-Russian language of instruction is carried out on the basis of a license (No. KZ 67 LAA 00018492) issued by the Committee for Providing quality in the field of education and science of the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan on July 28, 2020.

These EPs are implemented in accordance with the Classifier of areas for training personnel with higher and postgraduate education, the State Compulsory Education Standards of the Republic of Kazakhstan (GOSO), regulatory legal acts in the field of higher and postgraduate education, the Strategic Development Plan of the KorkytAt University for 2021-2025, the Academic Policy of the University [https://korkyt.edu.kz/index.php?Eption=com\\_k2&view=item&layout=item&id=4221&Itemid=1371&lang=ru](https://korkyt.edu.kz/index.php?Eption=com_k2&view=item&layout=item&id=4221&Itemid=1371&lang=ru)

The quality policy includes a set of the organizational structure of the university, indicators, processes and resources necessary to constantly improve the quality of education and develop a culture of quality, posted on the university website ([www.korkyt.edu.kz](http://www.korkyt.edu.kz)), reflected in the internal regulatory documents of the university, Strategic plan for the development of the KorkytAt University for 2021-2025.

The university has a system of internal and external quality control. Thus, by the decision of the Academic Council of the University, the "Regulations on Academic Councils for Quality" (protocol No. 5 dated December 15, 2020) was approved, published on the official website <https://korkyt.edu.kz/images/jhfljfv.pdf>; approved by the Internal Quality Assurance Standards (IQAS), approved by order of the Chairman of the Board-Rector No. 513-a dated December 29, 2020, published on the official website <https://korkyt.edu.kz/images/jgljkgk.pdf>.

The University has developed a Risk Management Regulation (Order of the Chairman of the Board-Rector No. 33-a dated 01/22/2021), published on the official website <https://korkyt.edu.kz/images/lglgljgljgljh.pdf>. In accordance with the Regulations, the departments of "Traditional Musical Art and Choreography", "Russian Language and Literature" developed a Risk Passport and a Plan-Report of measures to prevent risks.

Accredited EP 7M01407 - Music Education, 7M01722 - Russian Language and Literature, 6B017 84 - Russian Language and Literature in Non-Russian Language Schools are developed on the basis of national priorities and the Strategic Development Plan of the KU named after Korkyt-Ata for 2021-2025. The development plans of the EP were developed on the basis of the strategic plan for the development of the university, were updated and approved at meetings of the departments (AC Protocol No. 1 dated 08.28.21 according to EP 7M01722, 6V017 84; AC Protocol No. 2 dated 10.20.21, according to EP 7M01407). The direction of training is scientific and pedagogical with a term of study of 2 years. The language of instruction is Kazakh and Russian. The contingent of students under accredited programs is 16 people. 15 undergraduates are studying on an educational grant. On a paid basis - 1 undergraduate (*Table 6*).

The mechanism for coordinating the activities of all persons involved in the development and management of the EP is enshrined in the Regulations for the development and approval of educational programs in the KU. Korkyt Ata, which defines the competence of the Academic

Council in the areas of training of HPE personnel, graduating departments, employers and students. <https://korkyt.edu.kz/images/jhfljfv.pdf>.

As the analysis shows, the accredited EPs carry out their activities on the basis of the National Qualifications Framework (NQF), taking into account the Dublin descriptors and the EurEpean Qualifications Framework (ERF), including region-oriented competencies, defined by Korkyt-Ata and individual plans of students. In accordance with the requests of students, the requirements of employers and the labor market, the content of educational programs is adjusted through the catalog of elective disciplines (QED) and updating the work programs of academic disciplines. The management of the EP involves interested persons, stakeholders in the formation of the development plan for the EP. (AC Protocol No. 1 dated 28.08.21 according to EP 7M01722, 6V017 84; AC Protocol No. 2 dated 10.20.21, according to EP 7M01407)

Educational platforms Platonus, Googleclassroom are actively used in the educational process; online conferences, webinars are held using the ZOOM video resource. Teaching staff of accredited EPs effectively use interactive teaching methods in the classroom (presentations, work in small groups, associogram, etc.), modern digital educational resources.

In order to effectively train future specialists, graduating departments have EPened branches in production (Table 7), whose activities are regulated by the Regulations on the production branch of the department of NAO "Kyzylorda University named after Korkyt Ata". ( Protocol No. 10 dated 31.05.11), with amendments and additions (Prot. No. 5 dated 12.15.20, and Proto. No. 5 dated 10.29.21 ) [https://korkyt.edu.kz/index.php?Eption=com\\_k2&view=item&layout=item&id=4221&Itemid=1371&lang=ru](https://korkyt.edu.kz/index.php?Eption=com_k2&view=item&layout=item&id=4221&Itemid=1371&lang=ru)

Online interviews with the heads of the EP, teaching staff, students, as well as the analysis of the submitted documentation, confirmed the uniqueness of the accredited EP, which lies in the fact that:

- KU im. Korkyt-Ata is the only university in the region that trains Masters of Pedagogical Sciences in EP 7M01722 - Russian Language and Literature. - The EP was developed in detail together with the teaching staff of the department and colleagues from leading domestic universities (KazNPU named after Abay, KazNZhENPU)

- learning trajectories are directly related to the modern demands of society and the labor market, it is possible to form individual trajectories through the choice of elective disciplines and the language of instruction.

- MEP includes an interdisciplinary approach to the formation of the EP, interactive forms of teaching.

- bases of practices are actively involved ;

The university presents a feedback system focused on students, university staff and stakeholders. All interested persons have the EPportunity to make an appointment with the rector and vice-rectors according to the approved schedule, heads of departments in working mode without an appointment. It is possible to contact the rector personally through his blog on the university website <http://e-univer.korkyt.kz/>. This indicates the accessibility of management and its interest in developing feedback from stakeholders.

The survey revealed that the interviewed teaching staff satisfactorily assessed: the level of career growth - 66.2%, the availability of the university management - 80%, the created EPportunities for professional and personal growth for each teacher and employee - 44% of the respondents.

### ***Analytical part***

The university EPerates a system of electronic university " E -univer ", developed by the software department of the Kyzylorda University. Korkyt Ata. The use of this system demonstrates the EPeness and accessibility of accredited EPs, includes feedback from students, employers, teaching staff and other interested parties using such sections of this system as: electronic document management, the rector's blog, public services, blogs of department heads, IS "Institute ", IS "Department", IS "Teacher", IS "Student", IS "Applicant", "Electronic Library", "EPen Educational Resource".

EP 7M01407 - Music Education, 7M01722 - Russian Language and Literature, 6B01784 - Russian Language and Literature in Non-Russian Language Schools demonstrates the functioning of the mechanisms for the formation and regular revision of the EP development plan and monitoring its implementation, assessing the achievement of learning outcomes, meeting the needs of students, employers and society, making decisions aimed at continuous improvement of the EP. At the same time, EEC members recommend further improvement of management mechanisms and holding special events to involve representatives of stakeholder groups in the discussion and formation of the EP development plan. This prEPosal is due to the fact that the leadership of EP 7M01407 - Music Education has not sufficiently demonstrated transparency in the development of its development plan for the EP and orientation of its activities to meet the needs of the state, employers, students and other stakeholders .

The management of the educational process is associated with specific officials (head of the department, advisers, directors of institutes, their deputies, developers of educational programs, members of academic councils, university management). The duties performed are described in the job descriptions, the graduating departments are responsible for the business processes of educational programs. According to EEC experts, in the Self-Report, the management of the EP did not sufficiently demonstrate a clear definition of persons responsible for business processes within the EP, which was confirmed during the study of the documentation and online interviews.

In accordance with internal regulatory documents, the collection of information and its frequency in all the main areas of activity of the EP are regulated.

In the management activities of KU them. Korkyt Ata, a corporate network was introduced, the system of the information and educational portal "E-UNIVER", includes such sections as: the rector's blog, blogs of department heads, electronic document management, public services, IS "Dean's office", IS "Department", IS "Teacher", IS "Student", IS "Applicant", "Electronic Library".

To ensure the security of the information systems of the University, the server system of the information infrastructure of the University was transferred to the latest output EPerating

system Windows Server and Linux Ubuntu. For the convenience of working with users of application and server services, a single user registration on the ActiveDirectory server has been introduced. ExchangeServer 2010 using the @korkyt.kz mail server via corporate mail, university employees use the internal corporate network and access to the external environment. A new VMware virtual server has been created, through which information security has been enhanced.

The university library provides access to electronic information resources through the library's website <https://korkyt-nb.kz/>. To create a digital library and to develop the university's electronic library, in December 2020, the university purchased the MegaPro automated integrated library system, which provides remote access to use the library.

To conduct training sessions, the Licensed Module "Tasks" and the "Online Proctoring System" in the Platonus information system were purchased. An electronic class schedule has been compiled, which is posted on the university website

Within the framework of accredited EPs, a system of regular reporting is carried out, reflecting all levels of the structure, including an assessment of the effectiveness and efficiency of the EP. The annual report is heard at the meetings of the departments, the Council of the Humanitarian Pedagogical Institute (minutes of the extraordinary meeting of the department dated 06/28/2021, minutes of the meeting of the department [No. mail.ru/public/cQAD/twkhGp3qT](mailto:public/cQAD/twkhGp3qT))

An important source of information is the university-based sociological surveys of students, graduates and employers. Based on the results of the surveys, reports are compiled that are heard at meetings of the Academic Council, brought to the attention of the parties involved in the implementation of the EP <https://cloud.mail.ru/public/cQAD/twkhGp3qT>)

In accordance with the Regulation on Information Security, users of information systems, models of potential violators, means and measures of information protection, as well as information security requirements are defined (<https://korkyt.edu.kz/images/SDFvdsfv.pdf>).

The activities of the university are carried out by means of AIS ("Platonus", "E-UNIVER"), which are aimed at meaningful collection of information and purposeful control of the state and decision-making in the educational activities of the university.

The involvement of students, employees, teaching staff in the processes of collecting and analyzing information is carried out through an online questionnaire, the results of which are reported at meetings of the Academic Council, the Council of the Institute, the Academic Council. considered and appropriate action taken.

Evaluation of the effectiveness and efficiency of the EP is based on the analysis of reports, information, materials received as a result of internal and external audits.

### ***Analytical part***

The analytical work of the EEC on this standard showed that Korkyt Ata KU has an information management and monitoring system for enrollment of students, academic performance, staffing, which is regularly presented at meetings of the department, the Academic Committee, the Council of the Institute.

The department of strategic planning and quality management of the university conducts a sociological survey of all groups - students, teaching staff, employers, graduates, based on the results of which appropriate measures are taken.

Feedback has been established with students, which makes it possible to identify their needs and satisfaction with the quality of the implemented EP.

The university organized information support for scientific research of teaching staff and students. The Department for the Coordination of Scientific Research provides information and methodological support for the work of scientific departments, departments, Dissertation Councils at the university.

The scientific library has access to the international databases "ScEpus/Sciencedirect" and "Web of Science" under the national subscription of the Ministry of Education and Science

During the visit, the EEC was provided with information on the frequency, forms and methods for assessing the management of the EP, the activities of collegial bodies, structural divisions. Particular attention is paid to the systematic review of the effectiveness of decisions made, monitoring the activities of departments and programs at meetings of the Academic Committee. Thus, within the framework of the EP there is a system of regular reporting, which includes the effectiveness and efficiency of the activities of the departments and their evaluation at the university level. The departments prepare semi-annual and annual reports of an analytical nature, covering all areas of the department's activities. The structure of the reports is determined by the forms approved by the relevant documented procedures.

The university operates with a system of information support for students, which allows you to determine the degree of satisfaction of students with the learning process and provides feedback through the Platonus information base. Having a login and password, the student has the opportunity to follow the process of independent work, expressed in the assessment of the teacher.

The university provides teachers and students with free access to the Internet, there is Wi-Fi.

In accordance with the Law of the Republic of Kazakhstan dated May 21, 2013 No. 94-V "On personal data and their protection" and other regulatory legal acts of the Republic of Kazakhstan, the university teaching staff signed the Consent to the collection and processing of personal data (Contract for the provision of educational services).

The organization and conduct of professional practice for students of EP 6B01784 - Russian language and literature in schools with a non-Russian language of instruction are planned on the basis of the Rules for organizing, conducting professional practice (minutes No. 4 of October 29, 2021, <https://korkyt.edu.kz/images/replacePRACTICE.pdf> ).

All types of practice of students are carried out according to the academic calendar and are organized simultaneously with the educational process in close connection with the disciplines of the EP. Thus, according to EP 6B01784 - Russian language and literature in schools with a non-Russian language of instruction , a continuous educational (introductory) practice is planned for a period of 4 weeks in the amount of 2 credits. For the successful organization of this type of practice, the EP provides for the preliminary development by students of such disciplines as "Physiology of the development of schoolchildren", "Practical course of the Russian language", "PrEpaedeutic course of Russian literature". For future students of the 2nd year in the RUE EP, continuous psychological and pedagogical practice is planned, students will spend 1 day a week during the entire semester outside of class. At the same time, this type of practice is preceded by the study of disciplines: "Psychology", "Pedagogy", "Pedagogical design of the information educational environment ", "Management in education", "Theory and methods of educational work".

Since 2021, graduates of EP 7M01722 - Russian Language and Literature, 7M01407 - Music Education must pass the National Qualification Test, which is organized and conducted at the UStudy Educational Center in Kyzylorda. Students in EP 7M01722 - Russian language and literature.

Upon completion of studies, undergraduates are awarded the following qualifications:

EPs undergo internal (Academic Councils in the areas of personnel training) and external examinations (representatives of Associations, NGOs of the region, employers, strategic partners, representatives of business structures and other universities). Heads of educational organizations of the city and region are involved in the review of the EP, in particular the directors of leading innovative lyceum schools, private schools, representatives of the teaching staff of domestic universities ( <https://cloud.mail.ru/public/MQ8S/A6edx8E4v> , <https://cloud.mail.ru/public/9BdQ/6ChPk9HMi> .)

The management of the departments involves employers in the implementation of the EP, while taking into account their qualifications, work experience in educational organizations, the presence of a scientific or academic degree, titles and other achievements. So, the Academic Council for the Humanitarian and Pedagogical Direction as a representative of employers includes: director of the Kyzylorda branch of the "CPM" S.T. Kamalova, senior manager of the KF "CPM" Dzhansugirova Zh.D., Ph.D., senior lecturer branch of JSC NTsPK "Orleu" of the Institute for Advanced Studies of Pedagogical Workers in the Kyzylorda region Zh.A. Zh.Kizatova S.T.Sentayeva, a teacher of Russian language and literature of school-lyceum No. 7 R.M.Kilibaeva, who are involved in the development and revision of the EP. In the development of EP 7 M 01407 - Music Education - teacher-expert of the NIS of the city of Kyzylorda Zh.M. Utebaev, director of secondary school No. 171 named after G. Muratbaev B.S. Kyzylorda region B.T. Yeleusinov.

The strategic priority of the university is the internationalization of the university, aimed at expanding ties with foreign universities and integrating into the international educational space. Within the framework of the coEPeration agreement between the educational institutions "Orenburg State University" and the NAO "Kyzylorda University. Korkyt Ata" negotiations are underway on the development of SEPs.

KU them. Korkyt Ata developed the Graduate Model for all levels of education, which, in general, meets the needs of employers and stakeholders, is provided with the necessary resources for the educational process, including personnel, educational, methodological, informational and logistical support. Competence models of EP graduates correlate with the descriptors of undergraduate and graduate programs (<https://korkyt.edu.kz/images/ModelRUS.pdf>). At the same time, the EEC noted that the main conceptual ideas of the model (uniqueness and innovativeness) need to be developed through an individual learning trajectory focused on project-research activities, personal, professional and meta-subject results. In the presented Graduate Model, it is recommended to pay attention to the learning outcomes and their compliance with the requirements of the National Qualifications Framework (NQF), the Sectoral Qualifications Framework (SQF) of the Republic of Kazakhstan and the SES.

In general, the educational programs of this cluster meet the requirements of the labor market and the region, are developed taking into account the competence-based approach, the possibility of building an individual learning path.

Monitoring and periodic evaluation of EP 7M01407 - Music Education , 7M01722 - Russian Language and Literature, 6B017 84 - Russian Language and Literature in Non-Russian Language Schools is carried out by departments, faculty, Quality and Management Department and Educational and Methodological Department of the University based on the analysis of curricula , a catalog of elective disciplines, individual plans of students, internal regulatory documents governing the implementation of educational programs, minutes of meetings of departments, questioning of students, teaching staff, employers and interested parties. The results of the survey are reported at the EOperational meetings, meetings of the Academic Council, at the meetings of the graduating departments ( <https://cloud.mail.ru/public/QDKh/krNTHUdTa> )

The procedure for planning, developing and approving, making changes and further improving the EP complies with the legal documents governing the implementation of educational programs, is available to all participants in the educational process. All regulatory documents are completed in the UMK EP (“Rules for the formation of an educational and methodological complex of a specialty”, standards and UMKD (“Rules for the formation of an educational and methodological complex of disciplines”).

The university has support services that ensure the identification and satisfaction of the needs of various groups of students: the Department of Organization of the Educational Process, the Department of Educational Programs , the Department of Strategic Planning and Quality Management , the Department of International Relations , the Department of Postgraduate Education , the Recruiting Center .

To improve the organization of the educational process, the department of strategic planning and quality management conducts surveys among students (“ Student satisfaction with education at the university”, “Student satisfaction with the quality of education at the university”, “Satisfaction of students of the university to provide them with support”, <https://cloud.mail.ru/public/ip1p/zcASskiYT> , <https://cloud.mail.ru/public/ydHb/RTcVo5DdB> ) and teaching staff (“Teaching staff satisfaction with the university”, “Staff satisfaction”, “Involvement of teachers in R&D at the university” ( <https://cloud.mail.ru/public/cQAD/twkhGp3qT> )

Monitoring of the academic achievements of students is carried out through a discussion at the meetings of the department of academic performance, attendance, the results of passing the modules and the examination session. An indicator of the qualitative organization of the educational process is the good performance of undergraduates : (Table 8)

In the educational process, the teaching staff of the EP uses traditional and innovative forms and methods of teaching, digital, interactive technologies that provide for group and individual work of students. So, for example, in EP 6V01784 - Russian language and literature in schools with a non-Russian language of instruction, based on the results of monitoring RPM (syllabuses) and their periodic assessment, taking into account the updated content of education and the inclusion of ICT in the educational process, changes were made to introduce digital resources, use information platforms, methods of critical thinking, as well as elective courses: "Cognitive Linguistics", "Cultural Linguistics", "Active Processes in the Modern Russian Language". In EP 7M01407 - Music Education, 7M01722 - Russian Language and Literature, such disciplines as: "New Directions in Literary Studies", "Actual Issues of Lexicography", "Actual Issues of Bilingual Lexicography", "Integrative Linguistics and Its Applied Aspects" are introduced. "Modern educational technologies for teaching the Russian language."

TEPics of master's theses, reports on the implementation of the schedule for writing master's theses are discussed at meetings of the departments "Russian Language and Literature", "Traditional Musical Art and Choreography" (Minutes of the meeting of the TMI department No. 14.01.22) According to the requirements for supervisors of master's theses, specified in the order of the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan No. 604 dated October 31, 2018, supervisors of master's theses are Ph.D. Karimova B.S., Candidate of Philological Sciences, Associate Professor Bazylova B.K., Ph.D., Associate Professor Sh.M. Maigeldieva. The supervisors of master's theses in EP 7M01407 - Music Education are the Honored Worker of the Republic of Kazakhstan, Associate Professor M.B. Amze, PhD Dr. G.B. Baiulov. (<https://cloud.mail.ru/public/eQAD/twkhGp3qT>.)

#### ***Analytical part***

The University carries out constant monitoring, periodic evaluation and revision of educational programs in order to effectively implement the educational process. In the process of developing, implementing and revising the EP, involved employers, teaching staff, students and other interested parties. One of the common methods of involving students in the development of EP is to identify students' EPinions about learning outcomes (degree of satisfaction with the quality of educational services provided "Teacher through the eyes of a student").

Employers provide information on the needs of the labor market, the social needs of society in the relevant personnel, form the professional competencies necessary to conduct certain activities in the relevant EP industry, assist in the passage of all types of professional and research practice. EP 7M01722 - Russian Language and Literature and EP 7M01407 - Music Education, minutes of department meetings with the participation of employers were provided for the inclusion of new elective disciplines (TMI Protocol No. 1 dated 27.08.20).

Monitoring of accredited EPs is carried out through questioning of undergraduates, control of internal and external evaluation, systematic analysis of the general level of training and quality of mastering knowledge by undergraduates. The control of educational achievements of students in the studied disciplines is carried out on the basis of a point-rating system, which consists in conducting knowledge control (current, midterm control, final certification). Internal control is carried out by the NMS of the departments and the NMS of the university. External control is carried out by the Academic Councils in the course of the work of the SAC.

The graduating departments analyze the capabilities of the department (human resources, partnerships with schools) and the university (material and technical base) for the implementation of the EP, and also, on the basis of the NQF, OQF, PS, SES, conduct a study of the scEPe of professional activity, formulate the learning outcomes of the program, monitor and periodically evaluate the EP based on a questionnaire.

EEC members note that a systematic approach is used in monitoring and evaluating the implementation of the EP, which implies the complexity and mutual consistency of the analysis and adjustment of the course content, their continuity and consistency. Informing interested

parties is carried out on the university website [www.korkyt.edu.kz](http://www.korkyt.edu.kz)., on the pages of social networks instagram, facebook of graduating departments, as well as in group chats created in WhatsApp, Telegram . At the same time, according to the EEC experts , in the Self-Report, as well as during the visual inspection , the mechanism for making changes to educational programs was not confirmed, examples of publications of the changes made to the EP were not given.

As a result of the analysis RUP EP 6V01784 - *Russian language and literature in schools with non-Russian language of instruction* EPportunities to bring the content of the EP in line with modern trends in linguistics are identified. Thus, the EEC recommends introducing the discipline of **Corpus Linguistics** into the RUE EP, which can find practical application both in the development of language competencies and in the scientific work of EP students.

According to the results of a survey on the quality of teaching in university 97.8% of students are fully satisfied, 2.2% are partially satisfied; 98.9% of students are completely satisfied with the quality of study programs in the EP, 10.1% are partially satisfied, 91% of students are fully satisfied with the competence of the teacher, his possession of the taught material, 9% are partially satisfied

***recommendations for EP 6V01784 - Russian language and literature in schools with non-Russian language of instruction:***

- Ensure that changes are made to EP 6V017 84 - Russian language and literature in schools with a non-Russian language of instruction , in particular, introduce disciplines that correspond to modern trends in linguistics (for example, Corpus Linguistics), which can also be used to improve the language competencies of students for whom Russian the language is not native, until December 2024.

***EEC notes that EP 7M01407 - Music Education, 7M01722 - Russian Language and Literature, 6B01784 - Russian Language and Literature in schools with non-Russian language of instruction according to 9 criteria have satisfactory positions; 1 position suggests improvement***

***6.5. Student-Centered Learning, Teaching and Assessment Standard***

✓ *The management of the EP should ensure respect and attention to the various groups of students and their needs, providing them with flexible learning paths.*

✓ *The management of the EP should ensure teaching based on modern achievements of world science and practice in the field of training, the use of various modern methods of teaching and evaluating learning outcomes that ensure the achievement of the goals of the EP, including competencies, skills to perform scientific work at the required level.*

✓ *The management of the EP should determine the mechanisms for distributing the teaching load of students between theory and practice within the framework of the EP, ensuring the mastery of the content and achievement of the objectives of the EP by each graduate.*

✓ *An important factor is the presence of own research in the field of teaching methods of EP disciplines.*

✓ *The university must ensure that the procedures for evaluating learning outcomes correspond to the planned results and goals of the EP.*

✓ *The university must ensure the consistency, transparency and objectivity of the mechanism for assessing the learning outcomes of the EP, the publication of criteria and assessment methods in advance.*

✓ *Assessors should be proficient in modern methods of evaluating learning outcomes and regularly improve their skills in this area.*

✓ *The EP management must demonstrate the existence of a feedback system on the use of various teaching methods and the assessment of learning outcomes.*

✓ *The management of the EP must demonstrate support for the autonomy of learners, while being guided and assisted by the teacher.*

✓ *The management of the EP must demonstrate the existence of a procedure for responding to complaints from students.*

### ***Evidence***

EEC confirms that for the peer-reviewed EPs M01407 - Music education, 7M01722 - Russian language and literature and 6B017 84 - Russian language and literature in schools with non-Russian language of instruction in framework standard "Student-centered education, teaching and grade progress" provides evidence of the focus of the educational process on students; in particular, it is shown that students can independently: choose disciplines and teachers for the academic year online; view and upload your individual curriculum; track current, rating and final grades in your electronic journal; pass online tests by computer testing in disciplines during the period of intermediate certification; be able to appeal by discipline. The Report notes that "an individual curriculum is formed for each academic year on the basis of the RUE and in accordance with the QED, in which the student chooses disciplines on his own. Then the IEP is signed by the student, adviser-curator, head of the department and director of the institute. The approved IEP is transferred to the student. If the student has not registered and formed his IEP within the prescribed period, then the working curriculum of this course is taken as the basis for his training, while the elective disciplines are determined at the discretion of the directorate (Appendix 5.1) . This algorithm is clearly spelled out in the documents and is used as part of the educational process for peer-reviewed master's programs; its implementation is also expected according to EP 6V017 84 - Russian language and literature in schools with a non-Russian language of instruction .

Teachers of departments and cycle commissions preliminarily hold presentations of elective disciplines. The teacher gives a brief description of the course: the place and role of the course in the specialty program, goals, objectives and novelty of the course, as well as methods and forms of education. The choice of academic disciplines is carried out by students voluntarily in accordance with individual educational needs. It is noted that the individual educational trajectory consists of university (mandatory), variable, correctional and organizational parts, which is confirmed by the EP posted on the website of the RUP. The EEC confirms that the leadership and teaching staff of the EP provides for the use of a number of student-centered teaching methods in the educational process; the documentation regulating the educational process ensures its student-centered nature to a sufficient extent. The adherence to the policy of academic integrity is also confirmed (see the Code of Academic Integrity, <https://korkyt.edu.kz/images/jhfljfv.pdf> ).

The attendance of classes by members of the EEC allows us to assert that in the educational process according to EP 7M01722 - Russian language and literature and EP M01407 - Music education uses the following educational technologies and active learning methods (in particular, information and communication, interactive methods, case method, Bloom's taxonomy, project, seminar-discussion, etc.)

The university website also provides information on the appeal procedure, which allows us to speak about the presence of a student-centered algorithm for resolving problems that arise in the educational process. The student-centered nature of learning is also evidenced by the involvement of students in creative activities. So, undergraduates of the EP 7M01722-Russian Language and Literature Kuzembaeva R., Shamshatova G. and Berdikulova B. actively participate in the work of the "Literary Circle" as assistants to the leader in preparing undergraduate students for performances in various literary skits and theatrical productions, when writing scripts events and selection of participants.

### ***Analytical part***

Questionnaire of students (share of students of EP M01407 - Musical education among the respondents was 3.4%, the share of students of EP 7M01722 - Russian language and literature among the respondents - 9%) sufficiently confirms the student-centered nature of education. Thus, 95.5% of students demonstrated satisfaction with the availability of academic counseling and support with educational materials in the learning process; 98% of respondents

expressed satisfaction with the accessibility of the administration and the level of responsiveness of the management.

When attending EEC classes, it was revealed that the tEPics correspond to the syllabuses of the disciplines taught; the classes were conducted in an interactive mode, which also indicates the student-centered nature of education

The EEC also notes that the Regulations on the practice of undergraduates (Appendices, pp. 124-133) adequately reflect the student-centered nature of education (see Section Rights of the undergraduate).

The study by the members of the EEC of the IAAR of documents, the results of a survey of students, as well as attendance at classes in accredited EPs, showed the presence of a certain autonomy of the students of these EPs.

At the same time, the EEC notes that the Report contains a number of textbooks (including 3 recommended for EP 6V017 84 - Russian language and literature in schools with non-Russian language of instruction and 1 monograph), prepared by the teaching staff of the EP, a list of educational and scientific literature of the teaching staff of the department "Traditional Musical Art and Choreography", but specific examples (disciplines) are not given, acts of implementation of these manuals are not presented (protocols of the methodological council of the faculty, EMC or implementation acts)

As a result of the analysis of documents confirming the advanced training of the teaching staff, the EEC did not reveal the passage of courses in the field of modern methods and assessment techniques, which is one of the requirements under this Standard.

#### ***recommendations for EP 7M01722 - Russian language and literature, 6B01784 - Russian language and literature in schools with non-Russian language of instruction***

- EEC Recommends that the teaching staff complete advanced training courses on modern assessment methods until December 2023

#### ***recommendations for EP 7M01407 - Music education***

- ensure the availability of acts for the implementation of manuals prepared by the teaching staff of the EP in the educational process until May 2023.

***EEC notes that EP 7M01407 - Music Education, 7M01722 - Russian Language and Literature, 6B01784 - Russian Language and Literature in Non-Russian-Teaching Schools, according to 10 criteria, have satisfactory positions***

#### **6.6. Standard "Students"**

✓ *The university must demonstrate the policy of forming a contingent of students and ensure transparency, publicity of the procedures governing the life cycle of students (from admission to completion).*

✓ *The management of the EP should provide for special adaptation and support programs for newly enrolled and foreign students.*

✓ *The university must demonstrate the compliance of its actions with the Lisbon Recognition Convention, including the existence and application of a mechanism for recognizing the results of academic mobility of students, as well as the results of additional, formal and non-formal education.*

✓ *The university should provide an EPportunity for external and internal academic mobility of students, as well as assist them in obtaining external grants for study.*

✓ *The university should encourage students to self-education and development outside the main program (extracurricular activities).*

✓ *An important factor is the existence of a mechanism to support gifted students.*

✓ *The university must demonstrate coEPeration with other educational organizations and national centers of the "EurEPean Network of National Information Centers for Academic Recognition and Mobility / National*



Academic Recognition Information Centers" ENIC / NARIC in order to ensure comparable recognition of qualifications.

- ✓ The university should provide students with internship places, demonstrate the procedure for facilitating the employment of graduates, maintaining contact with them.
- ✓ The university must demonstrate the procedure for issuing documents to graduates confirming the qualifications received, including the achieved learning outcomes.
- ✓ The management of the EP must demonstrate that graduates of the program have the skills that are in demand in the labor market and that these skills are really relevant.
- ✓ The management of the EP must demonstrate the existence of a mechanism for monitoring the employment and professional activities of graduates.
- ✓ An important factor is the existence of an active alumni association/association.

**Evidence**

AT report on self -assessment of peer- reviewed EPs in framework standard "Students" noted that the procedure for admission of students to KU is regulated by the relevant requirements of the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan. In particular, it is indicated that according to the EP of the master's program 7M01407 - Musical education, 7M01722 - Russian language and literature, “ Admission to study is carried out in accordance with the Rules of the University Admissions Committee, developed in accordance with the norms of the Law of the Republic of Kazakhstan “On Education”, Model Rules for Admission to Study in an Educational Organization, approved by order of the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan dated October 31, 2018. <https://korkyt.edu.kz/images/norm6KAZ11.pdf>

For training in EP 6B01784 - Russian language and literature in schools with a non-Russian language of instruction, graduates of general secondary education institutions who have passed the UNT, who scored at least 75 points according to the test results and passed the creative pedagogical exam, are enrolled. <https://korkyt.edu.kz/images/norm6KAZ11.pdf>

The EEC confirms that the official website of the university has a section "Applicant" ( <https://korkyt.edu.kz/> ), which provides information on the rules of admission and the work of the selection committee. To form a contingent of students since 2020, the Recruiting Center has been operating at the university . As a result of the analysis of the site <https://korkyt.edu.kz/> The EEC confirms that the site provides detailed information on the EP (a catalog of elective disciplines is presented, which potential applicants and their parents can familiarize themselves with; qualifications that students will receive are also given).

EEC confirms the existence of a feedback system operating with the help of the information and educational environment of the university, which includes a portal and an electronic library, as well as a number of system and user resources made available to students .

The Report reflects the positive dynamics of the contingent for EP 7M01407 - Musical Education, 7M01722 - Russian Language and Literature ; as already mentioned above, admission is planned for the 2022-2023 academic year for the peer-reviewed bachelor's program.

***Analytical part***

The EEC notes that, in general, there is compliance with the requirements of the Standard. A conversation with students of the EP and graduates allows us to assert that the teaching staff of the EP and the administration provide complete information about the competencies and learning outcomes, as well as about the qualifications received and EPportunities for further employment.

The management and teaching staff of the peer-reviewed EP also provides support and development of students' competencies in the field of scientific work, which is especially important for students of EP 7M01407 - Music Education, 7M01722 - Russian Language and Literature. From the conversation with the students of the EP data, an algorithm for preparing scientific publications was revealed (the university provides undergraduates with the EPportunity to publish articles reflecting the results of their scientific research in the “Bulletin of KU Korkyt-ata”); consulting from managers in the process of preparation

At the same time, it was noted that in accordance with the requirements of the Ministry of Education and Science, students in accredited EPs are provided with EPportunities for internships, as well as participation in programs of leading Kazakhstani universities. EEC confirms the internship at KazNPU named after. Abai, but at present, including - and in the plan for the development of the EP, foreign universities are not indicated, which provide for the internship of students of the EP.

The management of the accredited EP did not demonstrate the program for the adaptation of foreign students and the ways of feedback with them.

The report states the fact that the actions of the university comply with the Lisbon Recognition Convention , but does not present internal documents on the basis of which the recognition of previous learning outcomes and qualifications is carried out.

The management of the EP does not provide information on the completion of an online scientific internship by undergraduates of the EP 7M01407 - Music Education .

- EEC recommends developing a plan for external and internal academic mobility of students by June 2023

***EEC notes that EP 7M01407 - Music Education, 7M01722 - Russian Language and Literature, 6B01784 - Russian Language and Literature in Schools with Non-Russian Language of Instruction have satisfactory positions according to 12 criteria***

### 6.7. Standard "Teaching Staff"

✓ *The university must have an objective and transparent personnel policy in the context of the EP, including recruitment (including invited teaching staff), professional growth and development of staff, ensuring the professional competence of the entire staff.*

✓ *The university must demonstrate the compliance of the qualitative composition of the teaching staff with the established qualification requirements, the strategy of the university, and the goals of the EP.*

✓ *The leadership of the EP should demonstrate the change in the role of the teacher in connection with the transition to student-centered learning and teaching.*

✓ *The university should provide EP opportunities for career growth and professional development of teaching staff, including young teachers.*

✓ *The university should involve in the teaching of specialists from relevant industries with professional competencies that meet the requirements of the EP.*

✓ *The university must demonstrate the presence of a motivation mechanism for the professional and personal development of teaching staff.*

✓ *The university must demonstrate the widespread use of information and communication technologies and software in the educational process by the teaching staff (for example, on-line training, e-portfolio, MEPs, etc.).*

✓ *The university must demonstrate its focus on the development of academic mobility, attracting the best foreign and domestic teachers.*

✓ *The university must demonstrate the involvement of each teacher in promoting a culture of quality and academic honesty at the university, determine the contribution of teaching staff, including those invited, to achieving the goals of the EP.*

✓ *An important factor is the involvement of teaching staff in the development of the economy, education, science and culture of the region and the country.*

Among the undoubted positive characteristics of the EEC is the presence of a competency-based model of teaching staff ( <https://korkyt.edu.kz/images/doljnosteisotrudnikov.pdf> ), which allows specifying the requirements for both applicants and those already working at the university teaching staff of the EP.

### **Analytical part**

EEC confirms that the links are working and fully reflect the features of the university's personnel policy and its compliance with the requirements of the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan; placement of the main documents that form the personnel policy of the university on the university website meets the requirements of its transparency. Qualitative indicators of the teaching staff of the department "Russian language and literature" and the department " Traditional musical art and choreography " reflect the

positive dynamics of degrees; the staffing rate is also high (93% and 90%, respectively). The Report describes in detail the principles of formation of the EP PPP rating, as well as the reporting system. Provides information about the mobility of teaching staff (mainly internal mobility). The EEC confirms that the teaching staff of the EP has publications in the ScEPlus database (reflected on the university website, as well as in Appendix 7.1 - Sh. Maigeldieva, B. Karimova), which is a necessary requirement for managing undergraduates.

The results of the questioning of teachers as a whole reflect the satisfaction of the teaching staff. The EEC notes that among the surveyed teaching staff EP 7M01407 - Music education accounted for 30.8%, teaching staff EP 7M01722 - Russian language and literature, 6V01784 - Russian language and literature in schools with a non-Russian language of instruction accounted for 18.5%. At the same time, the degree of academic freedom of the teaching staff is positively assessed by 99% of respondents; the degree of assessment of the possibility of professional improvement of teaching staff, the possibility of introducing innovations in the educational process, etc. is also high.

As part of the implementation of EP 7M01407 - Music Education, 7M01722 - Russian Language and Literature, 6B01784 - Russian Language and Literature in non-Russian language schools, the facts of academic mobility are reflected (mainly included, under an agreement with KazgoszhenPU).

EEC notes as a positive characteristic of accredited EPs the creation of branches of university departments (in particular, in the schools of Kyzylorda).

The EEC also notes the need for teaching staff to participate in joint research projects with Kazakh or foreign partner universities, as well as the lack of information about the creation of conditions for the development of young teachers by the university. At the same time, the EEC notes the need to develop outgoing academic mobility based on relations with foreign universities, since currently there is no information on the participation of teaching staff EP 7M01407 - Music Education, 7M01722 - Russian Language and Literature, 6B01784 - Russian Language and Literature in Schools with a non-Russian language of instruction in academic exchange programs.

- EEC recommends leadership of the EP submit a program of academic mobility, especially outgoing, taking into account connections with foreign universities, by January 2024.

***EEC notes that EP 7M01407 - Music Education, 7M01722 - Russian Language and Literature, 6B01784 - Russian Language and Literature in schools with non-Russian language of instruction, according to 8 criteria have satisfactory positions; 1 - suggests improvement***

### **Evidence**

AT report on self-assessment EP M01722 - Russian language and literature and 6B01784 - Russian language and literature in schools with non-Russian language of instruction in framework standard "Educational resources and systems support students" presents the dynamics of EP financing in sufficient detail. The EEC confirms that the credited EPs have all the necessary educational and material assets, developed infrastructure and material and technical base for educational and scientific activities. The area of educational premises, special laboratories and classrooms, sports halls meets the requirements for educational premises by the State Standard of the Republic of Kazakhstan on Higher Education. Indicators of the state of the classroom fund, provision with laboratory equipment comply with the regulatory requirements and conditions for the quality of educational services provided by the university. The material and technical base of the university includes 10 educational buildings, the Students' Palace, the Seihun sports and recreation complex, 6 student canteens, a library with 8 reading rooms, an agrobiological section, a greenhouse, a tactical training ground for the military department and 5 dormitories. The university has 5 hostels with a total area of 21993.4 m<sup>2</sup>: 3 student hostels for 1168 places, 1 hostel for undergraduates and doctoral students for 176 places and 1 hostel for teachers for 59 apartments. The area of indoor sports facilities of the university is 6486.71 m<sup>2</sup>, and the graduating department "Russian Language and Literature" assigned classrooms No. 122 - 31.80 sq.m, No. 123 - 25.20 sq.m, No. 124 - 25.20 sq.m., №125 im. A. N. Kantseva - 25.20 sq.m., No. 126 - 25.20 sq.m. and No. 100 "Creative Laboratory" - 47.60 sq.m., equipped with the necessary educational and methodological literature, stands dedicated to typical issues of linguistics and literary criticism ". For the implementation of EP 7M01 407 - Musical education, lecture rooms (3), 4 specialized classrooms, 1 specialized educational laboratory, 1 computer class, testing center, teaching, choir class, orchestral class are assigned to the Department of Traditional Musical Art and Choreography. The basis for the formation of classrooms and laboratories is the principle of specialization in EP.

The Report also reflected data on the growth of the book supply and the growth dynamics of the library stock. One of the positive facts is the presence of its own platforms [korkyt.edu.kz](http://korkyt.edu.kz) and "E-univer", as well as the use of the [Antiplagiat.ru](http://Antiplagiat.ru) program.

### **Analytical part**

The EEC noted that both at the university as a whole and within the framework of the EP, access to databases was provided and contracts were concluded with foreign CDs (Elsevier, Polpredcom, Springer, ThomsonReuters (WebofKnowledge platform), domestic digital libraries (RMEB, KAZNEB, EEB) Using the login and password of the teaching staff allows you to access English-language sites: databases of electronic resources of the companies THOMSON REUTERS, Springerlink All this makes it possible for the teaching staff of accredited EPs to

successfully scientific work, and also indicates compliance with the IAAR Standards in the field of educational resources and student support systems.

The EEC confirms the functioning of portals with authorized access: the class schedule, the modules "Online registration of applicants" are functioning, the EEC also confirms the use of the Antiplagiat.ru program to check graduation papers, as well as the existence of an agreement on the basis of which this program is used.

To the university created and there are academic support services for students: the office of the registrar (OR), the advisory service; the Annexes contain documents confirming the productivity of the research work of students and the support of this type of activity by the teaching staff of the EP and the university administration as a whole. Data on the functioning of student circles are given.

At the same time, in the information provided on library resources EP-7M01407 Music Education, there are not enough examples of the presence of Kazakh educational and scientific literature. EEC notes the need for replenishment library fund \_ \_ \_ 7M01407 - Music education with literature on the pedagogy of music education, the practice of training and shaping the personality of a teacher-musician, methodological developments on the problems of general music or music-pedagogical education.

#### ***Evidence***

The EEC confirms that the self-report according to this standard adequately reflects the process of informing the public about various aspects of the functioning of the EP and the

university as a whole. Thus, the website contains the Development Strategy of the University, information of a scientific and educational nature - the structure, history and achievements of the University, etc. The Report also provides data on the speed of the Internet, public Wi - Fi , etc. It is noted that on the Internet, on the website [https://www.korkyt.kz/index.php?EPTION=com\\_k2&view=item&layout=item&id=856&Itemid=905&lang=ru#](https://www.korkyt.kz/index.php?EPTION=com_k2&view=item&layout=item&id=856&Itemid=905&lang=ru#) provides information about events at the university, about all ongoing changes in the life of the university, informs about upcoming events. The press service of the university is responsible for posting this information. Important for the peer-reviewed EPs is the fact that in April 2021, the Department of Russian Language and Literature organized a republican webinar on the tEPic "Actual problems of training teachers: experience and prospects". In addition, the works of teachers and students are regularly published on the pages of the republican newspapers " Bilimdi El-Educated Country", "Bilim Ainasy", "Ustaz Masipker".

Direct communication with applicants and students of the university is carried out through accounts on social networks Instagram, Facebook, VKontakte, etc. (it is noted that the teaching staff of the EP are active users of social networks), as well as through regional printed sources.

### ***Analytical part***

The EEC confirms that complete information about peer-reviewed EPs, in particular, the RUE EP, [the catalog of elective disciplines of the EP](#), is in the public domain on the university website and is available to any interested person (for example, for undergraduate EPs, this information is available at [https://korkyt.edu.kz/index.php?EPTION=com\\_k2&view=item&layout=item&id=4657&lang=ru](https://korkyt.edu.kz/index.php?EPTION=com_k2&view=item&layout=item&id=4657&lang=ru), for master's programs - [at the link https://korkyt.edu.kz/index.php?EPTION=com\\_k2&view=item&layout=item&id=863&Itemid=916&lang=en](https://korkyt.edu.kz/index.php?EPTION=com_k2&view=item&layout=item&id=863&Itemid=916&lang=en) In 2021, as part of the 30th anniversary of the Independence of the Republic of Kazakhstan, the media plan "30 years of development and creation" was approved. According to the Plan, articles by teachers and staff were published in the media ( <https://korkyt.edu.kz/images/mediaplan02.pdf> ) The work to cover the activities of the university in general and the EP in particular in the media, as noted by the EEC, is of a regular nature: at the end of each week, media center specialists summarize the results of the work in a weekly report. Monitoring takes into account materials published in the media, social networks, information press conferences and links to the rector's posts posted on his personal page on social networks. Also, during the week, the results of news about past events on social networks and on the official website of the university are summed up. The video format for 3 minutes tells about the highlights of the week, and on the university website, a press digest is collected indicating links and tEPics of materials published in the media. So, information about the activities of the departments covering was published in newspaper articles of regional publishing houses: "Kyzylorda News", "To Whom What?", "Kyzylorda Times", "Rush Hour", on the KorkytAt University portal - the university website , other social networks: Facebook , Instagram , YouTube and others .

At the same time, there is not enough information on the site in the context of the EP (the information is mostly of a general nature, the above publications provide little information about the achievements of specific EPs, in particular, 7M01407 - Music Education, 7M01722 - Russian Language and Literature), detailed information about the teaching staff is not presented, there is no information on the possibility of employment of EP graduates.

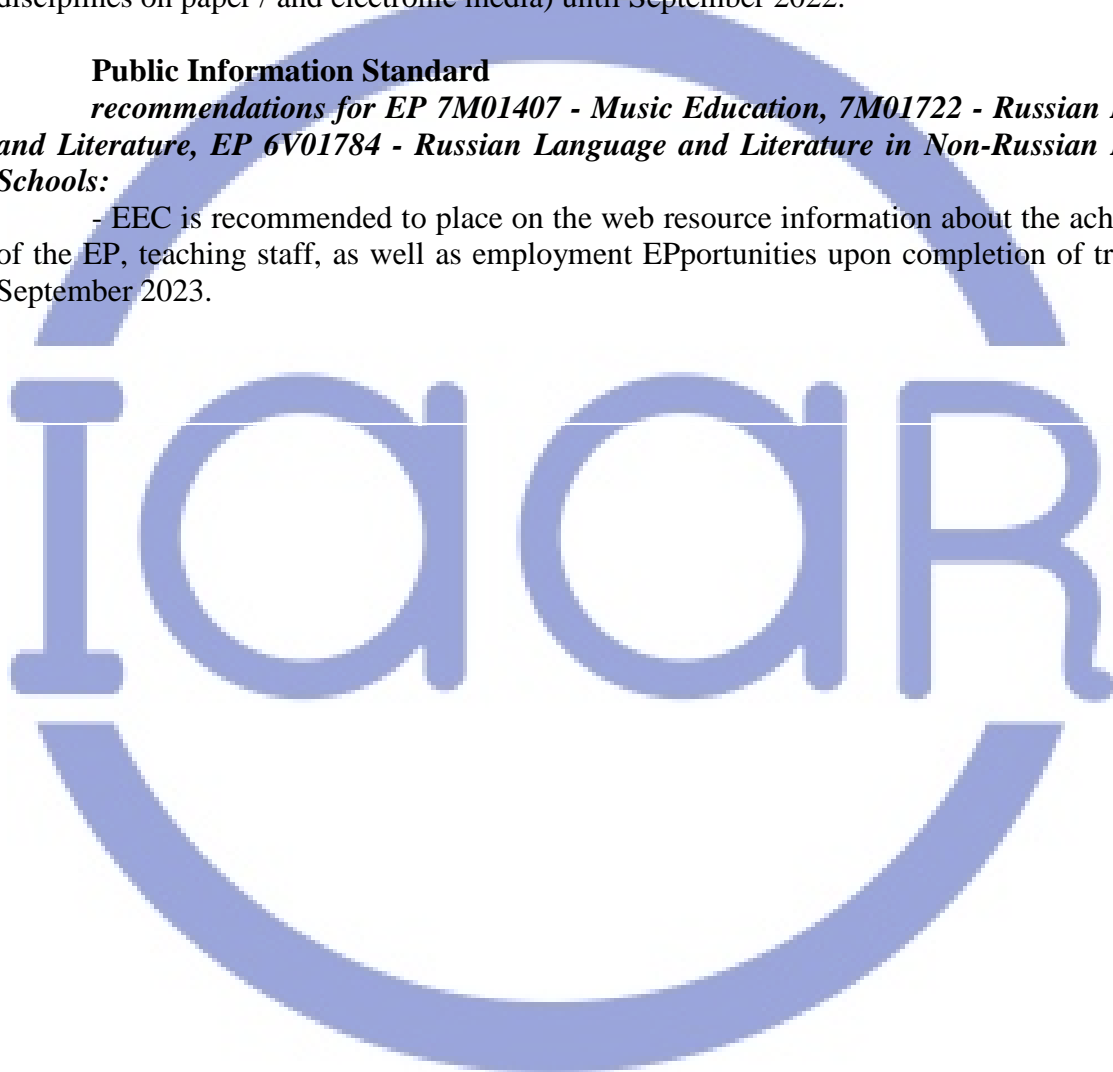
